Day One, 11/01/2022: Visit RENU, Makerere University, Innovex

We met with the team at Research and Education Network Uganda at Makerere University. The discussion centered around how RENU can better support the universities. The Meeting was attended by the ACTEA Team and Management team of RENU led by the CEO, Mr. Nicholas Mbonimpa. We resolved to set up virtual labs accessible by all members of the ACTEA consortium. Discussion of the possibilities of Artificial Intelligence were mooted.

MAK AI Lab were open to the idea and will engage to equip other universities.



Visit to Innovex

ACTEA team finished off the day by visiting the Innovex team. Innovex uses 3D printed modules to develop IoT devices for solar panels. Discussions centered around replicating 3D labs in partner institutions.
